*-Fun Filled Bonanza*



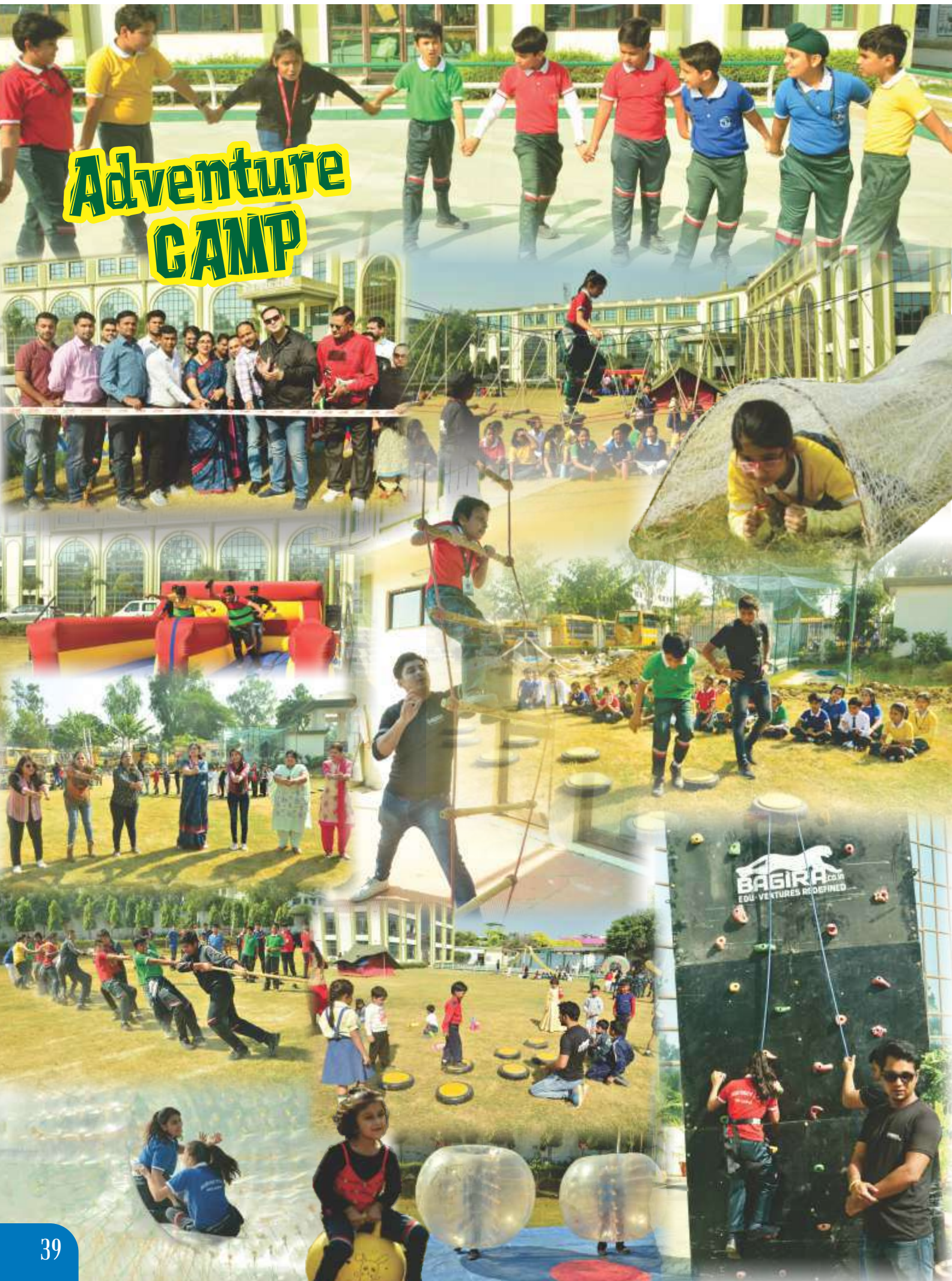

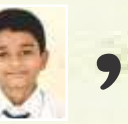

ए०पी०जे० अब्दुल कलाम का पूरा नाम अबुलपीकर जैनुलदेवेन अब्दुल कलाम था। उनका जन्म 15 अक्टूबर 1931 को रामेश्वरम, तमिलनाडु में हुआ था और 27 जुलाई 2015 को भारत के मेघालय के शिलांग में उनका निधन हो गया।

ए०पी०जे० अब्दुल कलाम देश के महान वैज्ञानिक और पूर्व राष्ट्रपति थे। वे भारत के लोगों के दिलों में 'भारत के मिसाइल मैन' के रूप में हमेशा जीवित रहेंगे। वास्तव में वे एक महान वैज्ञानिक थे जिन्होंने बहुत से अविष्कार किए। उन्हें 1991 में भारत रत्न, 1990 में पद्म विभूषण, 1981 में पद्म भूषण, 1997 में इंदिरा गाँधी राष्ट्रीय एकता पुरस्कार, 2000 में रामानुजम अवार्ड एवं 2007 में किंग चार्ल्स द्वितीय मेडल से सम्मानित किया गया था। वे वास्तव में देश के सभी युवाओं के लिए एक सच्चे दिग्गज थे। अपने पूरे जीवन, कार्य, पेशे और लेखन के माध्यम से नई पीढ़ी को उन्होंने हमेशा प्रेरणा दी है। बाद 2002 से 2007 तक भारत के 11वें राष्ट्रपति के रूप में उन्होंने देश को अपनी बहुमूल्य सेवा प्रदान की।

'इसरो' के लिए दिया गया उनका योगदान अविस्मरणीय है। भारत के राष्ट्रपति के रूप में अपने कार्यकाल के पूरा होने के उपरांत डॉ० कलाम ने विभिन्न कॉलेजों और विश्वविद्यालयों में अतिथि प्रोफेसर के रूप में देश की सेवा की।

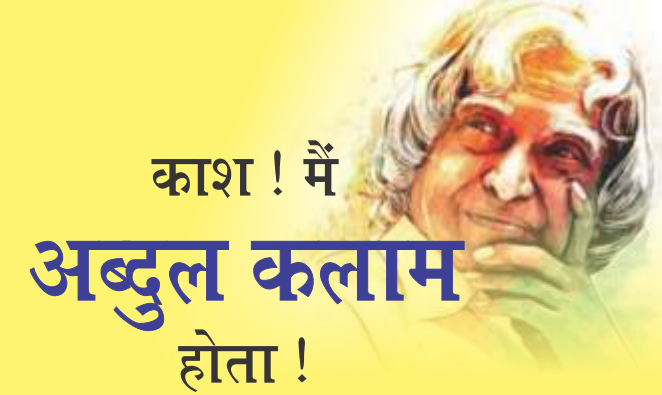
“मुक्त करो नारी को मानव, चिर वंदनी नारी को।

आर्यभट प्राचीन भारत के एक महान खगोलशास्त्री और गणितज्ञ थे। उन्होने 23 वर्ष की आयु में ‘आर्यभट्टम्’ ग्रंथ की रचना की जिसमें उन्होने खगोलविद और गणित का संग्रह किया। गणित और विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में उनके काम आज भी विद्वानों के लिए प्रेरणा का स्रोत हैं। इनका जन्म भारत का स्वर्णयुग कहे जाने वाले गुप्तकाल में हुआ था। गुप्तकाल में आर्यभट्ट जैसे महान वैज्ञानिकों की बढौलत साहित्य, कला और विज्ञान के क्षेत्र में भारत ने काफी तरक्की की। आर्यभट्ट ने ब्रह्मांड के रहस्यों को दुनिया के सामने रखा। उन्होने बताया कि हमारी पृथ्वी सूर्य के चारों तरफ परिक्रमा करती है और चाँद धरती का एकमात्र उपग्रह है। उन्होने अपनी गणना के आधार पर बताया कि वर्ष में 365 दिन होते हैं। आर्यभट्ट द्वारा की गई जीरो की खोज ने समस्त संसार को एक नई दिशा दी और इतिहास में इनका नाम अमर हो गया। आर्यभट्ट को उनके महान कार्यों के लिए पूरे संसार में जाना जाता है। भारत सरकार ने आर्यभट्ट के सम्मान में अपने सबसे पहले उपग्रह का नाम भी आर्यभट्ट रखा था। उनके द्वारा किए गए महान कार्यों के लिए उन्हें सदैव याद रखा जाएगा।

## हिंदी शब्द की उत्पत्ति

'हिंदी' शब्द की उत्पत्ति भारत के उत्तर-पश्चिम में प्रवाहमान सिंधु नदी से संबंधित है। अधिकांश विदेशी सिंह द्वार से ही भारत आए और जहाँ ठहरे वह 'सिंधु' का देश था। ईरान व भारत के संबंध प्राचीन काल से ही थे और ईरानी सिंधु को हिंदु कहते थे। हिंदु से हिंद बना और हिंद में फारसी भाषा के संबंध कारक प्रत्यय 'ई' के लगने से 'हिंदी' बन गया। हिंदी का अर्थ है-हिंद का। इस प्रकार हिंदी शब्द की उत्पत्ति हिंद देश निवासियों के अर्थ में हुई और आगे यह शब्द 'हिंदी की भाषा' के अर्थ में प्रयुक्त होने लगा। हिंदी शब्द के दो अर्थ हैं- 'हिंद देश के निवासी' और 'हिंदी की भाषा'। अब यह शब्द इन दो आरंभिक अर्थों से अलग हो गया है। अब इस देश के निवासी 'हिन्दी' नहीं बल्कि भारतवासी या हिंदुस्तानी कहलाते हैं। अब इस देश की व्यापक भाषा के अर्थ में 'हिन्दी' शब्द का प्रयोग नहीं होता क्योंकि भारत में अनेक भाषाएँ हैं जो हिंदी नहीं कहलातीं बेशक ये हिंद की भाषाएँ हैं, लेकिन केवल हिंदी नहीं हैं। उन्हे हम पंजाबी, बंगाली, असमी, उड़िया, मराठी आदि नामों से पुकारते है इसलिए हिंद की इन सभी भाषाओं के लिए 'हिंदी' शब्द का प्रयोग नहीं किया जाता। हिंदी शब्द भाषा विशेष का वाचक नहीं है, बल्कि यह भाषा समूह का नाम है जिसमें आज हिंदी क्षेत्र की 5 उपभाषाएँ तथा 17 बोलियाँ शामिल हैं।

## DIGITAL INDIA

Digital India is a campaign launched by the Government of India in order to ensure that Government's services are made available to citizens electronically by improved online infrastructure and by increasing Internet connectivity or by making the country digitally empowered in the field of technology.

Digital India was launched by the Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2015. He emphasized on National e-governance plan and has given its approval for Digital India. This programme has a vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy. It is to facilitate Indian citizens with electronic government's services in order to reduce paperwork, improve work efficiency and save time.

Some of the facilities which will be provided through this initiative are Bharat net, digital locker, e-education, e-health, e-sign, e-shopping and national scholarship portal. As part of Digital India, Indian Government planned to launch Botnet cleaning centers.

As of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018, India had a population of 1.3 billion, 1.23 billion Aadhaar digital biometric identity cards, 1.21 billion mobile phones, 446 million smart phones, 560 million internet users up from 481 million people (35% of the country's total population) in December 2017, and 51 per cent growth in e-commerce. India is now adding approximately 10 million daily active internet users monthly, which is the highest rate of addition to the internet community anywhere in the world.

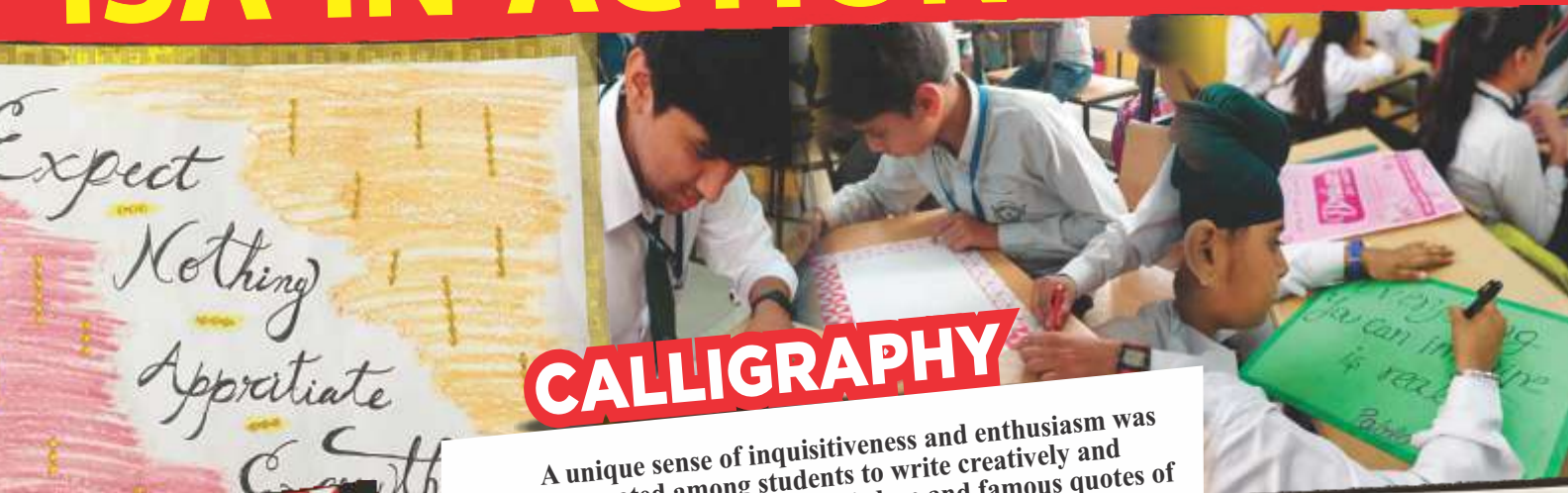

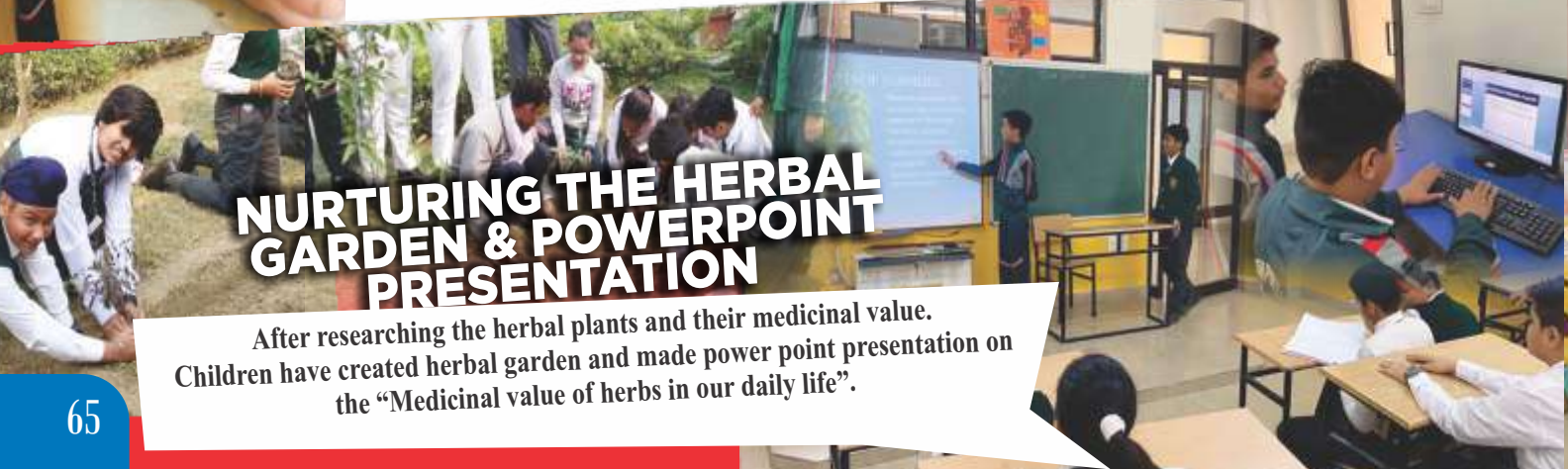
