


## F S PRINTS ON THE SAND OF TIME

Sports activity are important in school because they help in teaching various skills to students like leadership, patience, team efforts and social skills.





Independent India, Republic India, let us make it developed India.



"Earth rejoices our words, breathing and peaceful steps."








## Robotics Engineered to win

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) was launched in 2001, aims to provide universal access to elementary education in the country. The Vidya Scheme for Girl Students helps by giving one-time funding for female students. A breakdown of the costs associated with receiving financial aid is shown below. As part of this program, each girl would get between Rs. 10,000. Vidya Laxmi Portal was launched by the Government on August 15, 2015 to ensure that students can avail loans

easily through single window system of banks for education loans. All these measures taken by the government, have contributed a lot in the increase of literacy in India. So we all should look forward for a better future by trying to provide best quality education to all citizens of our country.

(Other Al's similar to ChatGPT also come in this category)

#### Pros of ChatGPT:

- Information Access: ChatGPT can provide information on a wide range of topics.
- Convenience: It's available 24/7, Allowing users to get quick answers or assistance at any time.
- Multilingual Support: ChatGPT can communicate in many languages breaking down the language barrier.
- Creativity: It can assist with generating creative content, Such as Writing, Brainstorming and Idea generation.
- Personal Assistance: ChatGPT can be used for personal tasks, like Setting reminders, Answering questions, Or providing recommendations.

#### Cons ChatGPT can impose:-

- Misinformation: ChatGPT generates incorrect or misleading information, Spreading false facts.
- Bias: It produces biased content or reinforce existing biases present in it's data.
- Privacy Concerns: Depending on the usage, It poses Privacy concerns, Especially when handling sensitive data.
- Lack of Critical thinking: Overreliance on ChatGPT discourages critical thinking and independent research.
- Ethical Issues: If used unethically, It can be employed for malicious purposes, Such as generating spam or fake news.

#### Why should we avoid using ChatGPT?

Aside from the above listed things, ChatGPT has been also shown to produce some terrible answers that discriminate against Gender, Race and Minority groups.

#### Chandrayaan-3

#### Why is chandrayaan important?

 The Chandrayaan mission holds significance not only for India's space program but also for the country's economy.

#### Main Points -

- Payload We had a bit of a complex payload for chandrayaan-2, with three key components to consider. These included the Lander, Rover, and Orbiter. -Chandrayaan-3's latest mission included only a rover and lander, as the orbiter had already completed it's mission in 2019.
- 2. Powerful lander The team behind chandrayaan-3 has made some significant changes after learning from the mistakes that were made during chandrayaan-2. The team working on Chandrayaan-3 has made some modifications examples • The legs of our lander have been made stronger than the previous version. Our engine capacity of the lander has been increased. Added a hazard detection to the lander.
- 3. Instruments The moon offers valuable insight for studying Earth, planning missions, detecting weather patterns, and observing exoplanets. - Chandrayaan-3 was launched with a new instrument called "SHAPE" meaning "Spectro Polarimetry of Habitable Planet Earth" to study exoplanets and collect data from Earth. This will help researchers learn more about habitable planets beyond our own.
- 4. Launch vehicle There is one more reason to launch chandrayaan 3, which is LVM 3 launch, because with this launch vehicle, "we can send heavier payloads into space."
- 5. The cost Chandrayaan-3 mission will have a smaller

budget than the previous one. It's great to see that our space programmes are becoming more efficient. Progress till date — "Chandrayaan-3 successfully completed Lunar Orbit, a major milestone achieved by the dedicated team behind the mission. We all are looking forward to further updates"

# हमारा लोक संगीत

लोक संगीत पहाड़ी से गिरते निर्झर के अनगढ़ और अनियमित उच्छलन और उसके नदी रूप में एक लय के साथ बहने की कल-कल का समन्वित रूप है। संगीत में यद्यपि नृत्य भी सम्मिलित होता है किंतु सामान्य तौर पर संगीत से आशय वादन और गायन से माना जाता है। जहां तक लोक संगीत का प्रश्न है तो इसमें वादन के उपकरण और उनको बजाने के संबंध में कोई निश्चित परंपरा नहीं है। इसके उपकरण अर्थात वाद्य बड़े अटपटे उल्टे सीधे और शुद्ध ग्रामीण होते हैं उनको बनाना और उनसे स्वर लहरियां निकलना केवल ग्रामीण जन के लिए ही संभव है। इन अनगढ़ वाद्यों से ऐसा सुंदर और कर्णप्रिय संगीत फूटता है जो शास्त्रीय संगीत से संबद्ध वाद्यों से भी नहीं निकलता।

लोक वाद्य यंत्रों के रूप में घड़ा, करताल, चिमटा, नगाड़ा, ढोल, डफली, बीन, बाँसुरी, तुरही आदि अनेकानेक चीजों का प्रयोग किया जाता है।

इन वाद्यों में हारमोनियम और नक्कारा सर्वाधिक तालवाले वाद्य माने गए हैं। लोक वाद्यों में ऐसे अनेक वाद्य होते हैं जिन्हें साधारण ग्राम्य जन भी आसानी से बजा लेता है। जैसे नरकुल से बांसुरी, तुम्बी से बीन और इकतारा। इसी प्रकार घड़े जैसी साधारण वस्तु भी कभी-कभी बाजे का रूप ले लेती है और फिर इसी से संगीत की उत्पत्ति कर ली जाती है। लोक वाद्यों के लिए किसी विशेष आसन या स्थान की आवश्यकता नहीं होती। वरन उठते-बैठते आते-जाते कहीं भी इन वाद्यों से स्वर लहरियां उत्पन्न कर दी जाती है।

ऐसा नहीं है कि शास्त्रीय संगीत में लोकगीतों और सुरताल का निषेध होता है। अनेक स्थानों पर शास्त्रीय संगीत की परिधि में भी लोकगीतों के गायन का प्रचलन है। शास्त्रीय संगीत की अनेक तालें भी लोकगीतों में प्रयुक्त होती है। अधिकांश लोकगीतों में ताल कहरवा ही बजाई जाती है। इसके स्थान पर द्रुत गति और अंतरे में वही ताल विलंबित गाई जाती है। ताल दादरा ब्रज के अनेक गीतो में बजाई जाती है। कुछ विद्वानों के अनुसार लोक संगीत में शास्त्रीय संगीत के साथ स्वरों में से केवल 'गांधार' और 'निषाद' का ही प्रयोग किया जाता है। अपार जनसमूह के सामने मनोरंजन के लिए गाए जाने वाले गीतों में लोक संगीत का अत्यंत महत्वपूर्ण स्थान है। यदि लोक संगीत को निकाल दिया जाए तो निश्चय ही लोकगीत से प्राप्त रस समाप्तप्राय हो जाए।




